Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

The planned reconstruction of Russell Street has caused evaluation of the existing 30-inch diameter Broadway Interceptor sewer line. The existing sewer line is planned to be reconstructed for approximately 75 feet. Both the upstream and the downstream portions of this interceptor were previously reconstructed. This portion was not included in that project due to the disruption of traffic on Russell Street.

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

The design and engineering portion of this project will be completed by May 2017 with construction beginning shortly thereafter and in conjunction with the Russell St. Sewer Re-Route project so as to minimize traffic disruption.
