Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Provides for professional development of new park masterplan and public involvement process as well as replacement of park irrigation system, regrading and soil amendments to ball fields, upgrades to ballfields, and replanting of trees - primarily fencing, backstops and dugouts, and reseeding. Playfair park's irrigation, fields, ball facility infrastructure, and trees are all over 40 years old and no longer in reasonable condition to sustain the level of user demand and expectations placed on these facilities due to age, condition; increased usage due to population growth; and changes in the law, policies, and standards (ADA, Zero waste, carbon neutrality, Park Design Standards).

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

The next phase will be to update the master plan to align with the Fairgrounds Master Plan. The implementation of the trail, way finding, parking, and landscaping improvements will be done in conjunction with other partners including the Fair, and Missoula County Public Schools. A potential exists for a shared satellite maintenance facility with the County. The FY 19 request of \$200K supports this facility.
