

## **Exhibit B – EXEMPTIONS – COMMUTER SHARED USE PATHS or TRAILS**

The following trails, or shared use paths, provide important transportation connections and are integral to the Active Transportation System. These paths are generally paved or hard surface, 8 feet or greater in width, available for year round commuting, and provide access/connectivity to open space conservation lands.

These commuter shared use paths or trails are exempt from the prohibitions in Chapter 8.58.010 (A) (6) Missoula Municipal Code. For the purpose of the exemption listed in 8.58.010 (C) (5) Missoula Municipal Code, “paths or trails” are defined by the paved or hard surface area only.
