FMRP Dog Park includes separate fenced areas for small dogs (under 14" or 30 pounds) and larger dogs. The dog park will open in late spring/early summer, when the turf has been established.

To maximize your and your pet's enjoyment, please honor the following:

USE AT YOUR OWN RISK. Owners are legally responsible for the actions and behaviors of their dogs.

Wait your turn and allow plenty of space at the double entry/exit gates.

Clean up dog waste immediately.

Dispose of used mutt mitts in receptacles.

Limit two dogs per handler.

Stay inside the dog park and in control of your dog at all times.

Keep a leash for each dog on your person and readily available at all times. Maximum, length, 6 feet.

Do not bring food or pet treats inside the park.

An adult must accompany children under the age of 14.

Dogs

Must be leashed at all times outside the dog park, remove leash inside the park.

Must be under voice command at all times.

Aggressive behavior is never acceptable. Please leave immediately.

Collars with current rabies tag and identification must be worn at all times. (No spiked or choke collars.)

Dogs in heat and puppies under 4 months of age are not permitted.

Digging is not permitted. Get your human to repair the hole immediately.

Excessive barking is not favorable to positive play.

Prohibited

Human and dog / treats	Glass containers
Dogs in heat	Puppies under 4 months
Aggressive dogs	Sick dogs
