

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Missoula City Council has adopted Resolution 8398, a resolution of intention to extend the duration of the Missoula Downtown Business Improvement District (BID) for an additional period of 10 years. The BID is proposed to promote private investment and business expansion in the district and to implement the specific projects and programs to accomplish those purposes. The Council will meet Monday, December 16, 2019, at 7:00 o'clock p.m. in the City Council Chambers, 140 W. Pine, Missoula, Montana, to hear and pass upon all protests that may be made against extending the duration of the district.

In order to protest, a property owner or the legally authorized representative for the property owner must file a written protest with the City Clerk, 435 Ryman, Missoula, MT 59802 no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, December 16, 2019.
