Description: Camps are open to children associated with students, staff and faculty of the University of Montana, ages four through middle school. Kids will explore, play, adventure and learn with engaging activities throughout the day! Includes games, arts and crafts, biking, fishing and more.

The schedule extends through September 18, and updates will reflect MCPS schedules as announced. No camps 9/7. Meets at Washington-Grizzly Stadium (drop-off at South Entrance) and the skybox facilities when indoor space is required.

- Elementary and middle school kids will be attending camp together; Parks staff will modify camp activities to meet the needs and abilities of all age levels.
- In consultation with the City-County Health Department, we’ve designed our out-of-school programs to serve students from any school, as in our summer day camp program. The UM program will meet in small, static groups with the same staff for the duration of the program to limit interaction among groups and facilitate contact tracing as needed. We will separate campers by school as much as possible.
- Parks staff will make every effort to enforce disease prevention best practices, including physical distancing whenever possible, masking when in close proximity, regular hand sanitation, and frequent sanitation of shared equipment/surfaces.

Remote Learning

- Day camps will include 1-2 hours per day of facilitated time to work on homework, read, or play educational game.
- If you would like your child to complete his or her schoolwork during this time, please send learning materials to camp with your child. No computers or valuables of any sort, please.
- For students who don’t bring schoolwork, we will provide games and books to work on basic academic achievement.
- While Parks and Recreation is not an education provider, we’re supporting remote learning by providing students time to work on assignments. We will not have access to computers during the September programs, but we hope to be able to facilitate technology-based academics later in the year.
- Play, adventure, and experiential learning have long been our standard approach to education, and will continue to be a strong component of our fall programming.

COVID-19 Prevention

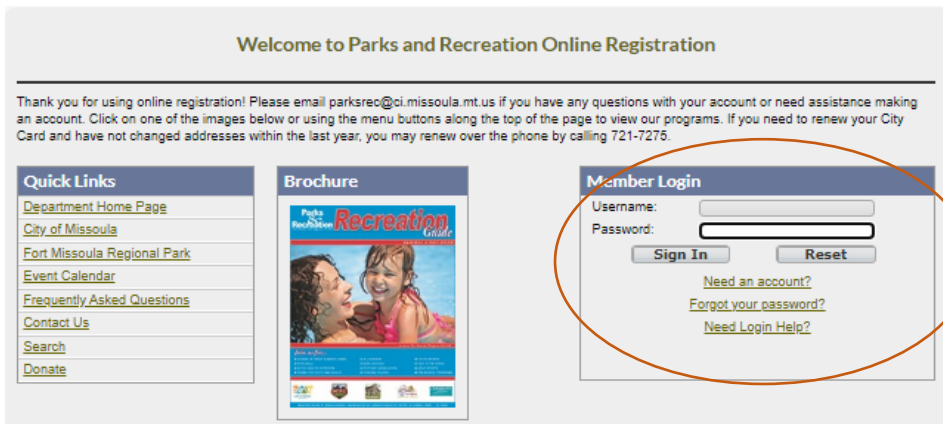
- Staff and campers must wear masks when physical distancing is not possible and when in transport vans.

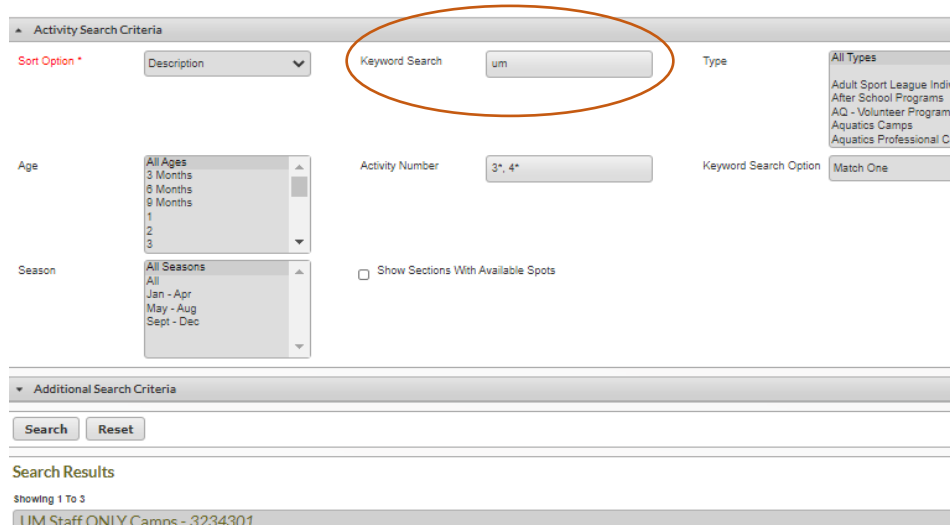
1. Log in to your account at www.missoulaparks.org/register to make sure your username and password are correct before registering. If you have registered for **any** Parks and Recreation camps in the past, you already have a Webtrac account!
2. If you do not know or remember your account login information, please email parksrec@ci.missoula.mt.us or phone 721-PARK before registering. **Creating a duplicate account will result in confusion for your family and our staff.**
3. **Enter in username and password** or click on **Need an account** (below the sign in button.) If setting up a new account, please add your children as family members at this time.
4. Webtrac, our online registration software, works best on desktop computers. **Please do not try to register on your phone or tablet.**
