

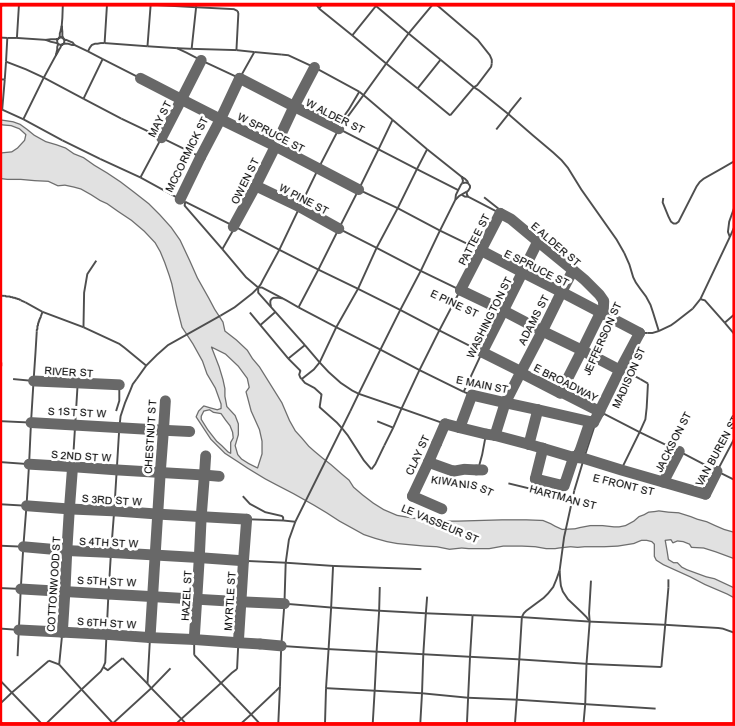
# 2021 Street Sweeping Schedule

Weather Permitting

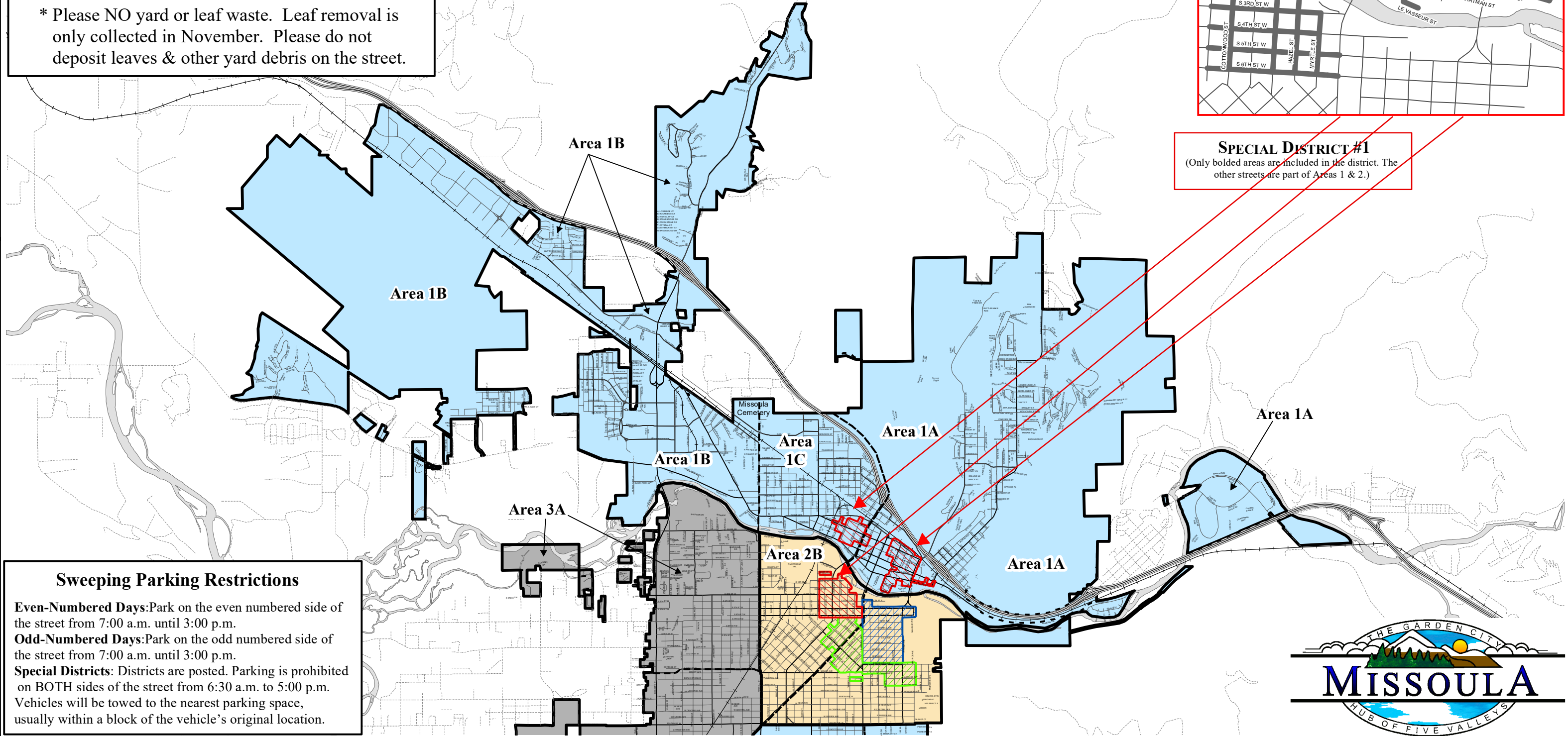
- Special District #1: April 6 / June 1
- Area 1A: March 30-April 9 / July 22-30
- Area 1B: April 14-30 / August 3-20
- Area 1C: June 2-9 / Sept 16-22

- \* Please see the back of the map for other areas.
- \* Please note that if we finish early with an Area, we will move into the next Area early as well.
- \* Please NO yard or leaf waste. Leaf removal is only collected in November. Please do not deposit leaves & other yard debris on the street.

# 2021 STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULE

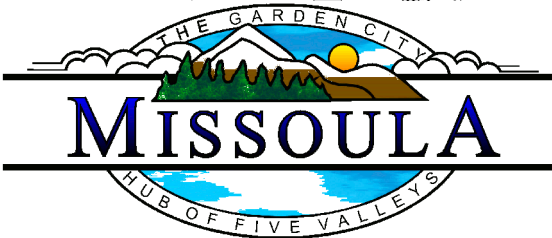


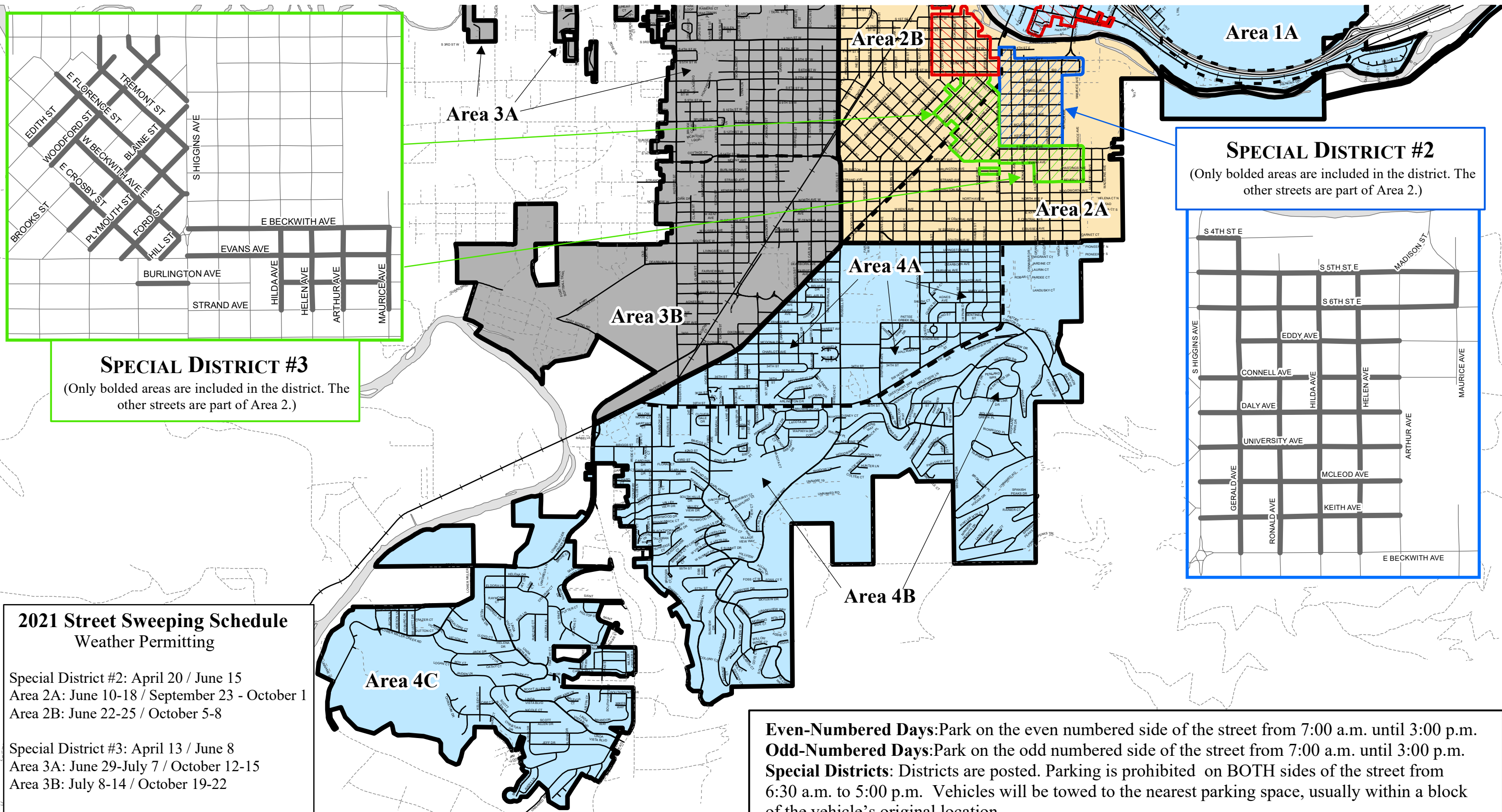
**SPECIAL DISTRICT #1**  
(Only bolded areas are included in the district. The other streets are part of Areas 1 & 2.)



## Sweeping Parking Restrictions

**Even-Numbered Days:** Park on the even numbered side of the street from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.  
**Odd-Numbered Days:** Park on the odd numbered side of the street from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.  
**Special Districts:** Districts are posted. Parking is prohibited on BOTH sides of the street from 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Vehicles will be towed to the nearest parking space, usually within a block of the vehicle's original location.

Special District #2: April 20 / June 15  
 Area 2A: June 10-18 / September 23 - October 1  
 Area 2B: June 22-25 / October 5-8

Special District #3: April 13 / June 8  
 Area 3A: June 29-July 7 / October 12-15  
 Area 3B: July 8-14 / October 19-22

Area 4A: July 15-21 / October 26-29  
 Area 4B: May 4-14/ August 24 - September 3  
 Area 4C: May 18-28 / September 7-15



**Even-Numbered Days:** Park on the even numbered side of the street from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.  
**Odd-Numbered Days:** Park on the odd numbered side of the street from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.  
**Special Districts:** Districts are posted. Parking is prohibited on BOTH sides of the street from 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Vehicles will be towed to the nearest parking space, usually within a block of the vehicle's original location.

Trees must be pruned to a minimum of 14 feet over the street to the inside edge of the curb line, per MMC 12.32. If your trees do not meet this requirement, they may be trimmed by the city in order to complete the sweeping.
