

4.24 NEIGHBORHOOD CLEANUP!

NLT Organizing Playbook

1. START WITH 3-5 CLEANUP CAPTAINS

You will need a team to help plan the cleanup, recruit volunteers, pickup supplies from Missoula Neighborhoods, and coordinate trucks/trailers for hauling to the Republic dump, A Republic-provided dumpster, and/or to Garden City Compost.

2. INFORM MISSOULA NEIGHBORHOODS

We are here to help you make your neighborhood cleanup a successful community energizer! Once you have your cleanup captains let us know ASAP so we can support your organizing work.

3. MISSOULA NEIGHBORHOODS SUPPORT

- Provide supplies with the help of Parks & Rec, including bags, gloves, pickers, and rakes.
- Coordinate with Republic Services to ensure you have free dump vouchers or a dumpster at your designated meeting spot or central City park.
- Send notices via your NH Listserv
- Provide flyers to Cleanup Captain to recruit volunteers
- Provide a large print of neighborhood map for day of coordination and smaller maps for cleanup captains

4. ORGANIZING

- Communications
 - Fliers, sandwich signs, facebook, Next Door, door knocking, texts, calls, emails
- Recruiting Volunteers
 - Block Captains
 - Find volunteers with trucks and trailers
 - Coordinate with local organizations and service groups
- Cleanup Supplies Captain
 - Pickup, dispense, and collect supplies from MNH
- Refreshments & Snacks Captain
 - Keep everyone fueled and working with your NC \$
