What is deconstruction?

Deconstruction is the dismantling of homes and buildings with the purpose of keeping building materials out of the landfill so that these items can be reused, repurposed, or recycled.

Why choose deconstruction over demolition?

- Reduces landfill costs
- Creates jobs and spurs local business growth
- Provides affordable materials to local community
- Preserves historic and valuable materials in the local economy
- Reduces greenhouse gas emissions/carbon footprint
- Reduces the demand for natural resources
