Street Vendors in Parking Lots

Missoula Municipal Code (MMC) Chapter 5.56 Street Vendors compliance with vendor location requirements shall be reviewed and approved by the City Engineer or a designated agent prior to Business License approval.

Street vending operations in the public right-of-way shall be in conformance with MMC 5.56.050 A.

Vendor operations conducted on private parking lots shall be in conformance with MMC 5.56.050 B, and be located so as to not obstruct emergency services access or create visibility obstructions or circulation impediments with the parking lot. Accessible pedestrian routes shall be maintained and may not be obstructed by vendor operations.

Section 5.56.050 B.3 states: "Street vending facilities shall be located at least fifteen feet away from any traffic or fire lane in a parking lot. Street vending operations shall be situated so as to minimize pedestrian traffic across any such lanes."

For the purposes of this Chapter, "traffic or fire lane in a parking lot" shall be defined as the primary access lanes as determined by the City Engineer, and/or any designated fire lane as determined by the City Fire Marshall. Primary access and fire lanes shall not be impeded or obstructed.
