Hi Elizabeth,

You may recall the Aspire Subdivision in East Missoula, which is about to begin 2nd Sufficiency review. There are some unoccupied homes on the property and what looks like a dog kennel. The developers would like to demolish the buildings in anticipation of new grading and construction following potential preliminary plat approval. Do you have any concerns with demolition of the buildings?

The application includes an historical resources report that addresses two of the buildings, but not the home in the SW corner. The report is in Section K of the application (link below). None of the buildings look noteworthy to me, but you are the expert on this topic so please let me know your thoughts.
