Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:									
<p>MPC needs more flexibility in how we can manage parking in our gated structures. We can offer more and different access options, including better data and tracking for decision making, in our gated facilities if we shift away from a gated access to a License Plate Recognition (LPR) access. This will allow us to better manage the valet parking, improve movement of users from waitlists into available spaces, and give us flexibility for offering daily parking options in addition to more hourly spaces when we see demand for it. Our current structures have PARCs gating equipment which requires hourly users (transient parkers) to pull a paper ticket or tap a card to enter the structure. Lessees (non-transient parkers) have a physical card that is required for ingress and egress. Ticket transports, credit card processors, PROX card and AVI card readers, and the physical gates all require regular maintenance and are easy for the public to access. The more a thing gets touched, the more maintenance it requires. LPR systems are "frictionless" and require zero touches and less maintenance.</p>									
History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed									
<p>This project is in line with section D of the Parking Commission Expansion and Optimization Implementation and Action Plan, which directs us to "procure a Virtual Permit Management System" and to "increase oversell in all facilities and seek to reduce reserved parking allocations". If the project is cancelled or delayed, we will be unable to procure a virtual permit management system or to reduce reserved parking allocations.</p>
