Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:																							
<p>As the Sxwtpqyen area grows and fills in with residential housing the need to provide trail connections from this area to the Milwaukee Trail becomes important for furthering the City's goals around multi-modal transportation and climate. This trail would connect from Broadway south to the Milwaukee Trail corridor. Much of this trail would follow an alignment on Airport property and a lease agreement will be required. As the airport continues to develop it's master plan City staff are in meetings to work towards including this trail route in their planning process.</p>

<p>A trail along the full length of Grant creek has long been a visionary goal of the City. If this trail is unable to be constructed then there will be less opportunities for many people living in the Sxwtpqyen area to bike and walk and sustainably commute into other parts of Missoula.</p>
