Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:								
<p>The Kiwanis Park master plan was envisioned in the North Riverside Parks and Trails Master Plan. An improved trail connection from Front Street to Ron's River Trail will be constructed as part of the Downtown SAM project. This trail will improve ADA accessibility and meet CPTED and AASHTO standards. The Kiwanis Club of Missoula is partnering with Missoula Parks and Recreation to provide additional amenities such as trees and benches that are outside the scope of the Downtown SAM project.</p>								
History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed								
<p>The new Missoula Library is directly across Front Street from Kiwanis park, making this a very important pedestrian and active transportation gateway from the park and trail system along the river into downtown. If the project is delayed or cancelled the current safety concerns around CPTED and accessibility of this section of park will remain and the city will miss an opportunity to connect the commuter trail system with the Missoula Library and downtown.</p>
