Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:									
<p>Provide an accessible river access, address erosion and impact issues and increase capacity at the Brennans Wave river access in Caras Park. The City of Missoula and Missoula Downtown Association have received an Economic Development Assistance grant from the Federal Government. The grant is around \$1.22M and requires a 20% match. Matching funding is provided from Missoula Downtown Foundation, Missoula Redevelopment Agency and Parks and Recreation funding sources. The project is currently being permitted, and a construction manager is under contract. Construction is schedule to begin in August 2024. Balance of funds related to prior year funding is appropriated for expense in FY25 via the FY25 Parks CIP update form.
