Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:							
<p>This project will design, purchase and install equipment necessary to allow the wayside horns/railroad crossing improvements project to be completed, thus silencing train horns at the Spruce/Greenough & Taylor St. railroad crossings except in emergencies. Funding for this project includes approximately \$192,000 from MRA Hellgate Urban Renewal District and approximately \$750,00 SID assessment funds.</p>							
History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed							
<p>The City entered into a contract with Triple Tree Engineering to develop a quiet zone analysis for the railroad crossing at the Madison/Spruce/Greenough intersection and Taylor Street. Various options were analyzed and a Wayside Horn Demonstration was conducted. The demonstration proved viable information/data and is the most economical and timely option to eliminate the sounding of train horns. The project got delayed in 2023-2024 with the relinquishment of the MRL railroad lease back to BNSF. BNSF representatives have stated that the City will need to fund Taylor St. railroad crossing improvements for them to silence train horns at the two crossings. If delayed, train horns will continue to sound, as they currently do, adversely affecting public welfare.</p>							
Are there any site requirements/ Potentially Affected Interest (PAI) Coordination:							
<p>The wayside horns and/or other crossing improvements can be sited on Burlington/Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) property, and coordination and permitting with BNSF will be necessary. The City will have to coordinate boring under Rattlesnake Creek for necessary Wayside Horn electrical equipment BNSF is requiring due to multiple tracks and switching gear. Some existing trees have already been removed to provide for visibility between railroad train engineers and the wayside horn equipment east of the Spruce/Greenough crossing. Coordination and support from the Lower Rattlesnake and area east of downtown will be necessary for SID (property owner assessments). BNSF will also need to coordinate and support the project.</p>
