Please describe the request and community benefit

The current Missoula City Council budget process requires a single up-or-down vote on the entire budget, regardless of any amendments made during deliberations. While efficient, this process limits the ability of council members to express support or opposition to specific, high-cost programs within a complex and dynamic budget.

This amendment proposes that any individual program or expenditure of \$500,000 or more be subject to a separate council vote. This approach will provide greater transparency, allow for program-specific discussion, and ensure that taxpayer dollars are directed toward priorities that align with community needs.

By evaluating substantial expenditures on their own merits, council members can make more informed decisions, improve fiscal accountability, and reinforce public trust in the budget process.
